Summary

The 50000&1 SEAPs project organized 4 webinars on how to implement in an integrated manner energy management and sustainable energy action planning.

The webinars aimed at increasing the pool of LAs, relevant stakeholders, as well as Covenant of Mayors Supporters and Coordinators informed and engaged with the 50000&1 SEAPs project. A total of 94 participants attended the webinars organized.

The topics chosen for the webinars reflect the barriers and challenges discussed and highlighted by participants, collected within the [Open Training sessions](#) held by the project. These include:

1. Focus on data challenges
2. Focus on municipalities developing a SEAP
3. Focus on funding & financing EnMS+SEAP
4. Focus on monitoring

1st Webinar - Integrating Energy Management and Sustainable Action Plans: Focus on data challenges

The first webinar took place on 16 September 2015 and it focused on the issues of data collection: who and how to ask for data; how to have access to the data you need; how to overcome data challenges.

Speakers included the Joint Research Center, and the coordinators of two European projects (DATA4ACTION and Meshartility) with which synergies are proactively sought.

Municipalities, Regional Authorities, Covenant of Mayors Supporters and Coordinators, public and private stakeholders were invited to participate in this online webinar. The webinar counted 29 participants.

2nd Webinar - Integrating Energy Management and Sustainable Action Plans: Focus on municipalities developing a SEAP

The second webinar took place on 22 February 2016, and it focused on the issues of implementation: how can Energy Management (EnMS) and Sustainable Energy Action Plans be integrated according to energy management standards such as ISO50001. The webinar addressed how to implement this integrated approach in municipalities that do not have yet a finalized SEAP, and it provided an overview of the first steps, tips and tools, recommendation on who to involve, and shared good practices from across Europe.

The webinar was attended by 33 participants.

3rd Webinar - Integrating Energy Management and Sustainable Action Plans: Focus on funding and financing

The third webinar took place on 3 November 2016 it focused on the topic of financing. The webinar counted 13 participants from municipalities, Regional Authorities, Covenant of Mayors Supporters and Coordinators, public and private stakeholders.

Speakers included the Executive Agency for Small and Medium Enterprise (EASME).

Through sharing expertise and best practices from Poland, Latvia and France, the webinar addressed the following questions, among others: how to fund and how to finance the activities, what to consider, how to set up PPPs.

4th Webinar - Integrating Energy Management and Sustainable Action Plans: Focus on monitoring

The fourth webinar took place on 23 February 2017, and it focused on discussing how to implement and monitor actions integrating EnMS and SEAPs, in municipalities that already have a SE(C)AP in place: what to consider, tips and tools, who to involve.

Thanks to the participation, among the speakers, of a representative from the Energy Management Working Group (EMWG) of Clean Energy Ministerial (CEM), participants were to exchange and reflect upon experiences of Energy management in the U.S. and internationally.

19 participants attended this webinar.
